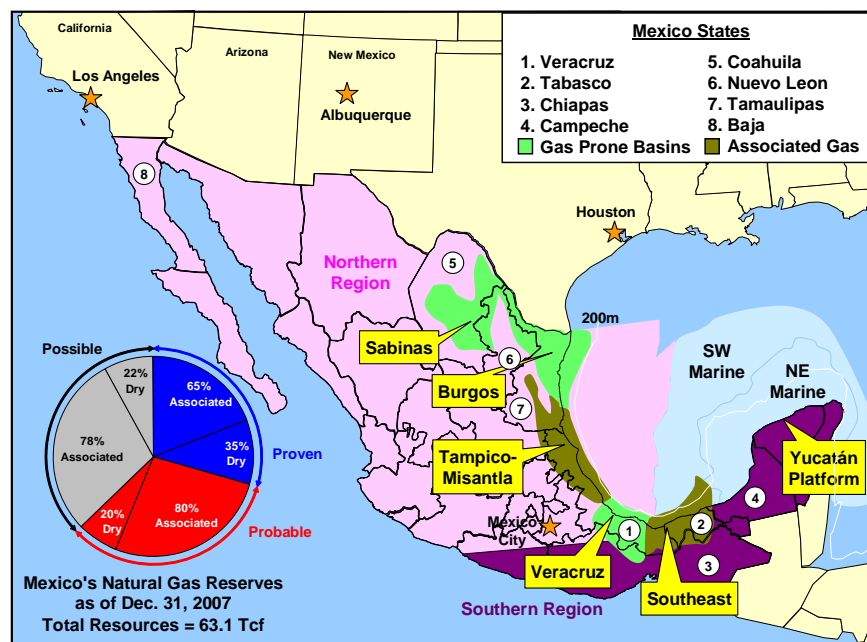
***Mexico's Natural Gas Supply / Demand Outlook to 2016***

Ziff Energy announces the release of a report which provides a summary of Mexico's gas supply and gas demand. Mexico has a large natural gas resource potential, but currently must import natural gas to balance domestic demand.

"Recently passed energy reforms provide incentives for foreign companies to participate in exploration and development but will likely not spur the levels of activity required for Mexico to be self-sufficient" concludes Bill Gwozd, Vice President, Gas Services at Ziff Energy.
